

## Tilton Police Department Press Release



September 29, 2016

This week, the Tilton Police Department executed a search warrant on a vehicle following a traffic stop which occurred on Monday evening near the intersection of Laconia Road and Route. 93 for a false inspection sticker. Officers first observed the vehicle meet another vehicle in the park and ride area just off exit 20 in Tilton. After stopping the vehicle, Officers observed evidence of illegal drugs in the vehicle and requested a search warrant.

After getting the warrant this week, Officer executed it on the vehicle and recovered a large shipment of suspected Heroin, Fentanyl and Crystal Methamphetamine. They also recovered a large amount of cash, more evidence of drug sales and a stolen handgun, reported stolen out of Boston Mass.

The seizure netted over 750 grams of Heroin with an estimated street value of \$80,000 dollars and a large bag of Crystal Meth. The Officers traffic stop took a large amount of two very dangerous drugs off the street and which was clearly intended to be sold in the area.

The Tilton Police plan to seek federal drug and weapon's charges against the two people involved:

Bryan Franklin, age 39 of 82 Washington Street, Penacook NH and Cre Clay age 21 of 2 Spaulding Street, Nashua for their involvement.
